ORDER:

Government after careful examination of the matter keeping in view of the Orders, dated 14-08-2025 of the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana at Hyderabad in W. P. Nos. 5382, 9163, 9942, 10149, 10166 & 10168 of 2021, hereby constitute the following Committee to consider the grievances of the persons effected by the Notifications issued under Section 22-A (1) (e) of the Registration Act, 1908:

1.	The Secretary to Government & Chief Commissioner of Land Administration, Telangana, Hyderabad	Chairman
2.	Retired Judicial Officer of the rank of a District Judge (to be appointed by the Government)	Member
3.	The Commissioner and Director of Survey, Settlement & Land Records, Telangana, Hyderabad.	Member – Convenor

- 2) (i) The Committee is empowered to examine relevant records and then pass a reasoned order either accepting or rejecting the grievance by confirming/ deleting/ modifying any such property from the notified list of properties. Such orders passed by the Committee shall be binding on the State as well as on the aggrieved person and in the event of any of them being aggrieved thereby; they shall have to approach a Competent Court of Law for redressal of their grievance.
- (ii) The tenure of the above said Committee shall be three years from the date of issue of this order.
- (iii) The committee shall meet at least once in a month.
- (iv) The remuneration payable to the retired judicial officer shall be last salary less pension drawn as per usual rules.
- 3) The Secretary to Government and Chief Commissioner of Land Administration, Telangana, Hyderabad shall take further necessary action accordingly in the matter.
